- When:** Monday 11th January to Wednesday 13th January 10 am - 4 pm
- Content:** Introduction to basic radio skills including panel operation, digital recording and editing, script writing and presentation. A class limit of 10 people applies to ensure maximum flexibility to meet individual needs. Teachers with current skills may complete extension sessions to build these skills. The workshop also covers the basics of working with Radio Adelaide as an RTO, i.e. student activities and projects, useful resources, record -keeping and assessment tools to meet the requirements of the Screen and Media Training Package CUF07
- Accreditation:** Participants will be assessed against 2 units of Certificate II in Creative Industries (Media) CUF20107. Teachers with current skills can negotiate for assessment or recognition for extra units.
